New Water System is now in use

On November 17th the new Water Tower and Well 5 were put into service. By 1:00am Friday morning the system was fully pressurized and things were operating normally. Although there is still some work to do at Well 1 and the Cistern a substantial part of the work has been completed.

Using Chlorination to Eliminate Potential Bacteria

As most of you know over the years we have had a problem with Total Coliform showing up in water samples during the summer months. This problem has become worse over the years and needed to be addressed. We have used a number of non invasive methods to clear up this problem with no success. With the new system coming online it provided us a way to safely chlorinate the system and provide the proper amount of disinfection needed. It is important that disinfection reaches all parts of the system. We test the chlorination levels daily to maintain a chlorine level that is safe and still effective. We will continue this process until we are ensured that all areas of the system have been chlorinated properly. With the low volume of water this time of year it may take some time.

Water Line Extension on Mustang Becomes Part of the Water Tower Project

After all is said and done and the bills are paid there are still enough funds left from the USDA Grant funds for one more water line. The new 1,200ft line will run between Chinook and Groundhog along Mustang as shown on the map below. By closing this loop it will provide better pressure and dependability to those serviced by lines in the area. Work is scheduled to start on this last phase of the project in early December.



Air in the water makes for cloudy water

Lately you may have noticed that your water is coming out a white color. This is caused by air in the lines and happens from time to time. With the design of the new system, water is pumped directly into the tank before it goes out to the system, this gives the air time to dissipate before being introduced to the system.

Your current water pressure

Now that the new water tower and well have been put into use, most members should see an increase in water pressure. There are some areas that already had a pressures above 65psi and may not have experienced an increase. On homes that we estimated would have a increase in water pressure above 80psi we placed a pressure reducing valve that is set at 75psi.
